DIFFERENT LODGE ACTIVITY OPTIONS:

Track Leopards in the Okonjima Nature Reserve:

LEOPARD VIEWING:

The leopards roam freely and catch their own prey within the 200km² (50 000 acre) (20 000ha) Okonjima Private Nature Reserve. Carnivores are radio-collared to allow for regular monitoring of their well-being and for research purposes! Sightings are not guaranteed.

Track Cheetah | Spotted Hyaena | Wild Dog on Foot:

LARGE CARNIVORE TRACKING ON FOOT:

These 'rehabilitated' carnivores roam freely and catch their own prey within the 200km² Nature Reserve. Carnivores are radio-collared to allow for regular monitoring of their well-being and for research purposes! Sightings are not guaranteed.

Self-guided Walking Trails:

NATURE TRAILS:

Self-guided walking trails for those guests who want to spend some time alone in the solitude of the Okonjima wilderness. Maps available at reception.

Birding on Okonjima:

BIRDING TRAILS:

Identify some of the 250+ species in the area, including some of the Namibian endemics
(PLEASE PRE-BOOK FOR SPECIALISED BIRDING)

NIGHT DRIVES:

After dinner, a 1½ hr night drive into the Okonjima Reserve is on offer. The night drives are weather and participation permitting. Please check daily with reception if drive is on offer. Additional Cost.

A Visit to R.E.S.T. {Rare & Endangered Species Trust} REST IS A NON-PROFIT ORGANISATION THAT FOCUSES ON THE "FORGOTTEN 5".

REST started a supplementary feeding scheme in 2001 in order to provide a safe site for monitoring. Their "restaurant" (meat partly sponsored by OKONJIMA & THE AFRICAT) - is one of the most successful in the world with 500 -1000 wild vultures feeding ONCE a week. A short 15km drive will get you to R.E.S.T. Additional Cost.
