



Okonjima & AfriCat

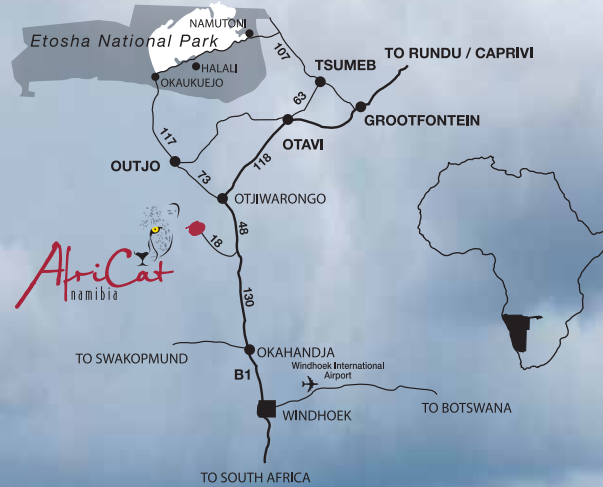
