



How to get to Okonjima

2 1/2 hours drive north of Windhoek on the B1

To those coming from the South on the B1:
Take the gravel turn-off to the left, just after the sign "Otjiwarongo 50km".

To those coming from the North on the B1:
Take the gravel turn-off to the right, just after the sign "Okahandja 130km".

This turn-off is approximately 48km South of Otjiwarongo,
and is marked "OKONJIMA 10km".

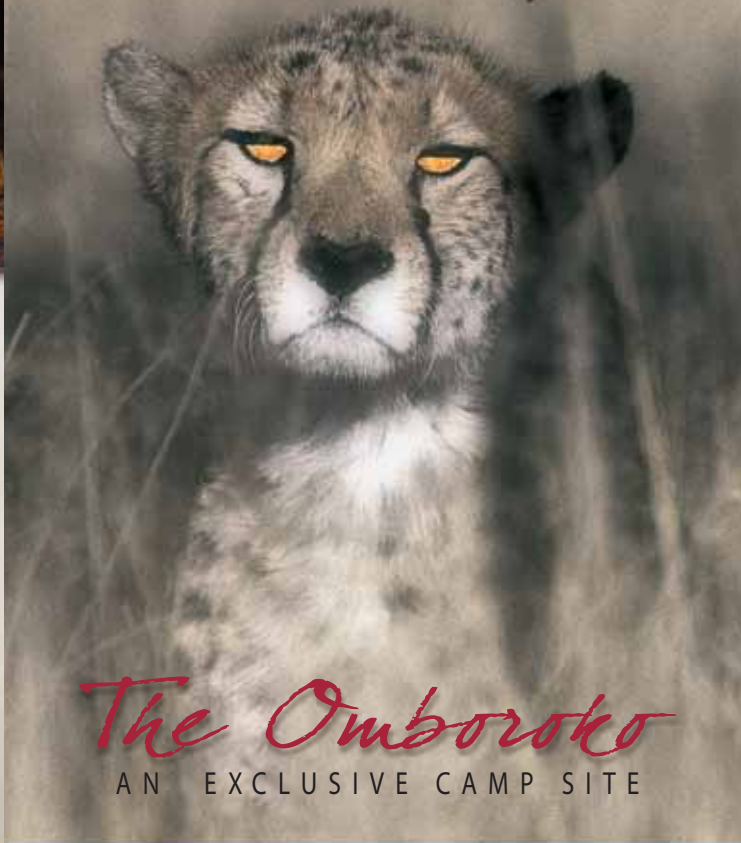

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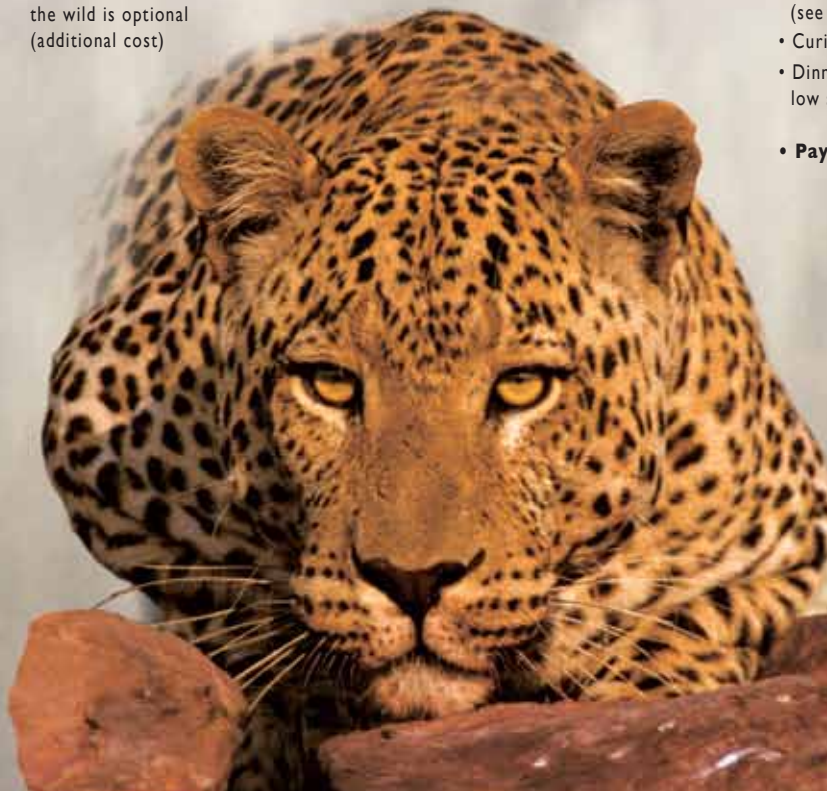
The Africat Carnivore Care & Information Centre:

This guided tour offers you valuable insight into the work of Africat. Okonjima is world renowned for excellent opportunities to view and photograph cheetah and leopard.

The Bushman Trail:

Follow in the footsteps of an ancient people on the guided Bushman trail. It constitutes an easy walking trail and is highly informative. You get to learn about the art of making traditional artifacts and how the San adapt and survive in an unforgiving wilderness environment.

PRICE INCLUDES:

Walking Trails through a Wilderness Area:

Trails up to 8km are available, made with varying degree of difficulty. Okonjima have positively identified over 250 bird species, which include most of Namibia's endemics.

Campsite Facilities:

- Each Private Campsite offers: showers with hot water
- flush toilets
 - under-roof scullery and dining area
 - sundowner viewpoint
 - fire wood

Swimming Pool:

One exclusive swimming pool shared by all campsites.

Electricity:

One fixed spotlight per campsite for cooking and packing. One plug point will be available for the charging of fridges, cameras, cell phones etc.

PLEASE NOTE:

- The Omboroko Camp Site is a self catering facility!
- Guests must provide their own food, drinks and all camping gear eg. tents, sleeping bags etc.
- Closest Town to stock-up with supplies is: OTJIWARONGO – 74km from Okonjima or OKAHANDJA - 130km from Okonjima (see website for directions).
- Curio Shop and Lunch available at the Day Centre (Prior booking)
- Dinner / Brunch at Plains Camp: Limited availability / low season only / prior booking necessary / additional cost)

West of the Waterberg Plateau Park in Namibia, the vast plains are occasionally broken by the remnants of ancient Sandstone 'outcrops', which once covered large areas of northern Namibia. Nestled among the "Omboroko Mountains" lies **Okonjima** - a Herero name meaning "place of the baboons". It's much more than a luxury Lodge and a Camp Site. **Okonjima** is also home to **The Africat Foundation**. **Africat** is a non-profit organization, committed to long-term conservation of Namibia's large carnivores, particularly leopards and cheetahs. Our mission is to make a significant contribution to **Conservation Through Education**. We will continue to strive towards the long-term survival of Namibia's carnivores in their *Natural Habitat*.

OKONJIMA is half-way between Windhoek and the Etosha National Park (10km from the B1)!
